Recreational Fire Permit Application

Please complete the information below and sign the application. Pursuant to Robbinsdale City Code Section 910.47 a permit is required for recreational fires for in ground fire pits, and portable units. The fee for a Recreational Fire Permit is \$50 and will remain effective providing you maintain residence at the address listed below. The permit is valid for permanent and portable fire locations, subject to the conditions necessary to maintain safe burning standards as defined by the Minnesota State Fire Code and Robbinsdale City Code.

Please initial below for all recreational fires to indicate that you understand and will abide by the listed requirements:

- _____ Recreational fires must be on private property and a minimum of 10 ft. from all property lines.
- _____ The person in charge of the recreational fire must be 18 years or older and a resident of the permit address and shall be present for the duration of the fire, including extinguishing the fire.
- _____ Only clean, dry firewood shall be used, and flames shall not exceed 2 feet above the base of the fire. Oils, rubber shingles, painted or treated lumber, leaves, trash or garbage shall not be burned.
- _____ The prevailing wind at the time of the fire shall not exceed 5 mph.
- _____ Fire extinguishing aids shall be immediately accessible, i.e. garden hose, shovel, extinguisher.
- _____ Recreational fires shall not start before 9:00 a.m. and must be extinguished by 11:00 p.m.
- _____ The recreation fire permit must be kept at the permit address and be available if requested.
- _____ Fire Official's or Police Officers are authorized to require that recreational fires be immediately discontinued if any requirement is violated, or the fire is determined to constitute a hazardous condition. Any person(s) who fail to comply with these conditions shall be in violation and have their permit revoked. A citation for violation of city ordinance may also be issued.
- _____ In ground fire pits shall be constructed with a maximum diameter of three feet and minimum depth of one foot. The outer ring shall be constructed with a non-combustible material.
- _____ In ground recreational fires shall not be constructed within 25 feet of a structure. (i.e. garages, houses, sheds, fences, decks, roofs, or combustible material).
- _____ Portable fire containers shall have a maximum diameter of three feet and minimum depth of one foot and shall be made with non-combustible material.
- _____ Portable fire containers shall not be placed within 15 feet of a structure (i.e. garages, houses, sheds, fences, decks, roofs, or combustible material).




Recreation fires shall not start before 9:00 a.m. and must be extinguished by 11:00 p.m.
