41st Avenue Construction Update

August 14, 2024

The City of Robbinsdale will be reconstructing 41st Avenue between Regent Avenue and Railroad Avenue beginning Monday August 19th, 2024.

This project will include the installation of water mains, sanitary sewer mains, and storm sewer infrastructure including catch basins, pipes and storage chambers.

During the week of August 19^{th,} the contractor, GMH Asphalt, will be working on the removal of pavement, curb and gutter, sidewalk, driveways and trees.

Beginning on Monday August 26th, the intersection of Regent Avenue and 41st Avenue will be closed to install water main. The intersection will be closed for approximately 2 days. Residents in the Parker Village neighborhood will need to use 41 ½ Avenue or 40 ½ Avenue to access the neighborhood.

There will be occasional water shutdowns when the contractor is working near existing water mains. You will be notified 24 hours before a shutdown will occur.

During this project access across 41st will be limited and full closures will change daily, depending on where the underground work is occurring.

Access to properties between 40th Avenue and 42nd Avenue will be available, but you will need to use either 40th or 42nd to access them.
